

## Junior Assistant Scoutmaster

The Junior Assistant Scoutmaster is a youth leader making the transition to adult leader. One or more are appointed by SM.

**Prerequisite:** Must be 16 years old. Must have served as SPL or be an Eagle Scout. They may be 17 years old and at least a Life Scout.

Reports to: Senior Patrol Leader, ASMs, and SM

### Duties Include:

- Function as an Assistant Scoutmaster
- Accomplish any duties assigned by the Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmaster
- Serves as a member of the Patrol Leader's Council
- Assists the SPL, ASPLs, and Assistant Scoutmaster, and Scoutmaster in keeping order at Troop meetings
- Attend Youth Leader Training.
- Advise Scouts on appropriate Scout behavior
- Assist in the conduct of the meeting as appropriate

And as with all other Youth Leaders -

- Sets a good example
- Enthusiastically wears the Scout uniform correctly
- Lives by the Scout Oath and Law
- Show and help develop Scout spirit
